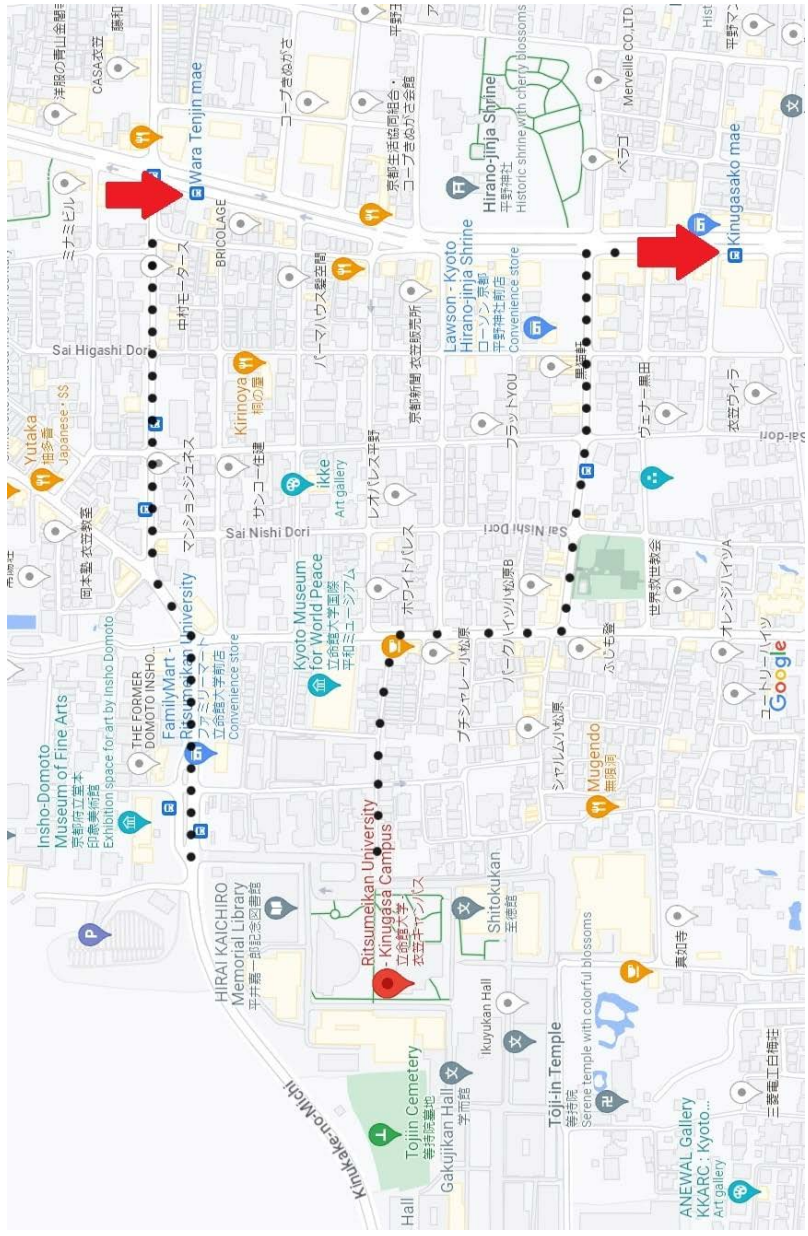
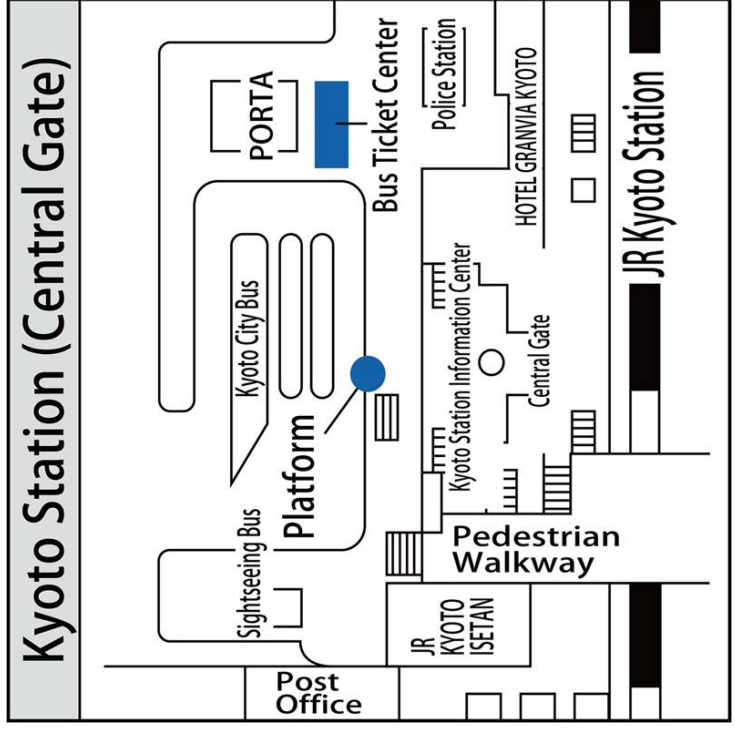

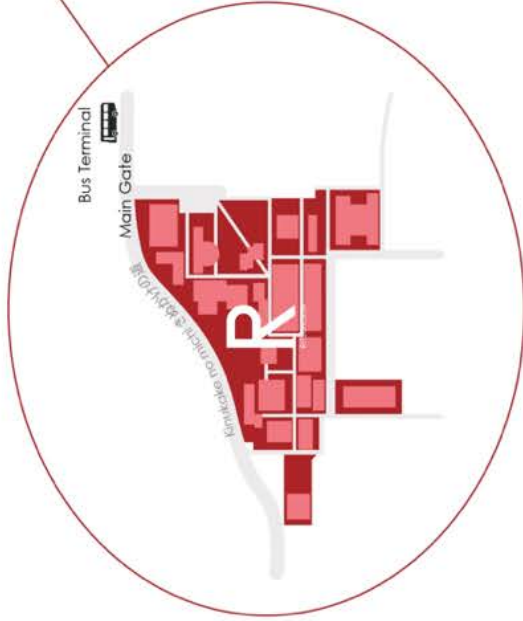

Kinugasa Campus Access Map

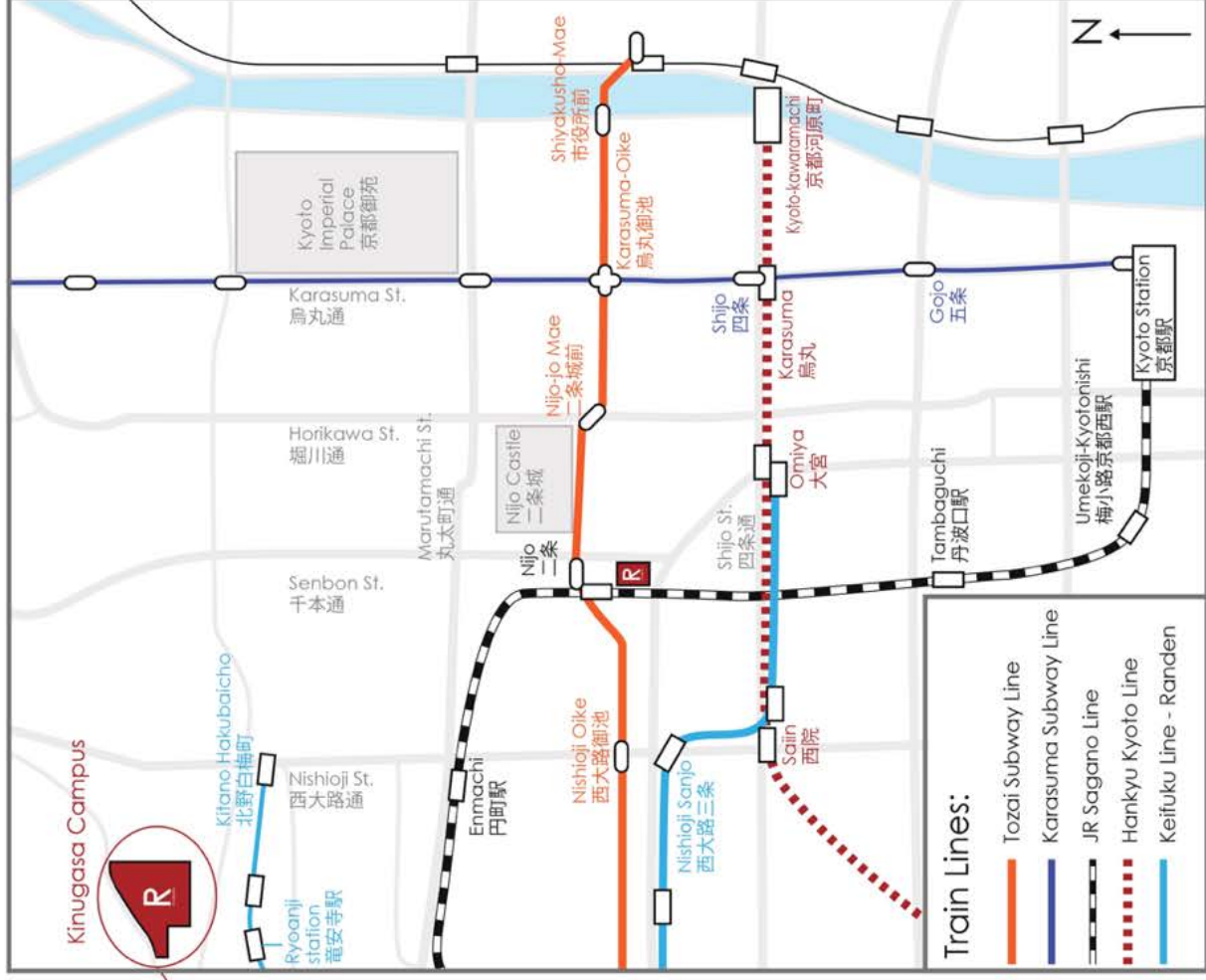
56-1 Toji-in Kitamachi, Kita-ku, Kyoto 603-8577
